

Accessing AIR Ways Reporting for Teachers

AIR Ways provides information on student performance on Benchmark Modules. When users log on to the system they see the Dashboard page. The Dashboard provides a summary of all the assessments your students took. More detailed reports with item analysis and a view of actual student work can be accessed from the dashboard page.

Note: The type of performance data that appears in AIR Ways varies by test type. For Benchmark Modules, performance level data will appear.

AIR Ways Reporting Card

1. On the SAGE portal select your user role.
2. Click the **AIR Ways Reporting** card. The login page appears.
3. Enter your email address and password.
4. Click **Secure Login**. The Dashboard will appear.

Teacher Dashboard

The Dashboard will display the overall summary of score data and testing information. The **My Assessments** table displays average score and/or performance distribution of all assessments for your students and the **My Students** table displays a list of most recent assessments that your students have taken.

The data you see are dependent on your role; for example, a teacher only sees data for their students.

From this page, you can see how your students performed on a *specific assessment* or you can see how a *specific student* has performed across assessments.

Teacher Assessment Report

To view how your students performed on a specific assessment, you can click on the name of the assessment from the **My Assessments** table on the dashboard.

This report provides score, performance, and/or points earned for the selected assessment of all students. This report can be used to compare how individual students have performed compared to the rest of the students. It also displays the five assessment items with the highest or lowest average score for your students, which helps you analyze their strengths and weaknesses.

Student Item Response

When you click on the student's score under a selected item, you can see student's actual response including the item details and item rubric. This report can help you analyze the student's understanding of individual item topics.

Knowing how a student performed on a specific item and seeing the student's work helps you better understand what your students know and don't know. By viewing the student's actual response, you can begin to pinpoint student's misunderstanding of key concepts.

Student Portfolio Report

To view performance for an individual student across assessments, you can click on a student in the **My Students** table on the dashboard.

This report provides score and/or performance data for all assessments the student has completed. From this report, you can also access the student's item response on a selected assessment.
