

Dear Parents,

Thank you for wearing your mask when you come to our schools. This has made a difference and it shows your compassion and support of these great student athletes we have at our school. For this reason, we are imploring you to be diligent in continuing to wear your mask at our schools and events.

As we look forward to the final games of the season for some sports, we begin transitioning to many of our indoor winter athletic events and performances. In a meeting on Oct. 20, with the local health department and IHC regional medical center, there is significant concern about the increase in COVID cases in our communities and in our schools. There is also concern that these winter activities are in jeopardy of continuing.

In order to ensure we can keep schools open for our students, the current mask requirement at all events will be more strictly enforced. We have met with our local city leaders and our School Resource Officers and have agreed that visitors who refuse to wear a mask at our school properties will be asked to leave. If they refuse to leave, they will be issued trespass citations, which will result in possible future charges and impact that person from visiting our campuses in the future (even if they are the parent of a student). We are asking you to put personal beliefs aside and comply with the current mask requirements while on our school properties.
