- **Student-paced learning** using pre recorded video lessons and digital activities provided in the Schoology learning management system along with digital curriculum and other digital software.
- **Scheduled live Meets** for essential learning and so students can build friendships by working and learning together.
- **Hands-on activities** that students will complete at home to connect learning with the real-world.

Our purpose is to support the learning needs of our students by designing learning where the teacher:

- **Hears from every learner** to frequently check understanding.

- **Collects meaningful evidence** of mastery of learning.
